ProClean® Drain Line & Grease Trap Treatment is based on the same biological technology as ProClean® Concentrated Drain Cleaner. The difference is that ProClean® Drain Line & Grease Trap Treatment uses a high concentrate of selectively adapted bacteria to degrade greases, fats, long-chain fatty acids, and other organic wastes.

It is ideal for commercial locations, such as restaurants, where a heavier concentration of waste products can clog drains quickly. Regular use of ProClean® Drain Line & Grease Trap Treatment helps prevent buildup in drain pipes and reduces the amount of grease trap pumping required by as much as 65 percent.

The unique formula uses a blend of selectively adapted microorganisms. The microbes in ProClean® Drain Line & Grease Trap Treatment eat organic waste and turn it into carbon dioxide and water.

Through daily use, grease and other organic matter will buildup on the sides of the pipes. Even a new drain system can develop problems in a few months. Buildup can cut the flow rate by one-half or more.

ProClean® Drain Line & Grease Trap Treatment builds a biofilm of microbes on the walls of the drain lines and traps. It works around the clock, consuming grease and organic waste before it has a chance to buildup. The microorganisms in ProClean® Drain Line & Grease Trap Treatment are similar to those found in nature. They do not contribute to pollution. They aid municipal treatment plants by beginning biodegradation upstream. ProClean® Drain Line & Grease Trap Treatment is approved for use in drain and sewage lines and complies with EPA requirements.

ProClean® Drain Line & Grease Trap Treatment eliminates foul odors, including hydrogen sulfide, the familiar "rotten egg" smell. Applications should always be made during the system's longest period of non-use. Usually this is after clean-up at the end of the day. Slow running drains and overloaded grease traps should be cleaned prior to beginning the treatment program. For best results, the product should be injected daily with the Time Flow Meter (see the previous page for details on the Time Flow Meter).
